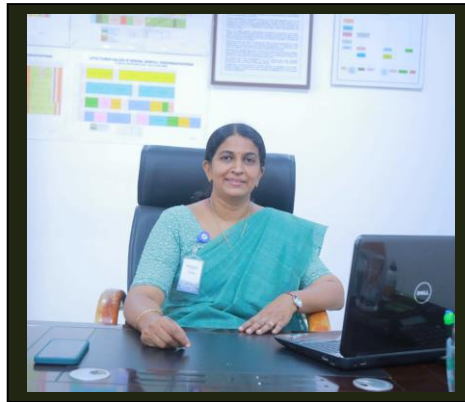
Overall, the program was successful and meaningful, fostering stronger alumni bonds and encouraging future collaboration.

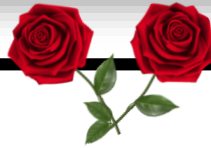
- **Purpose:** To support nursing students with their education expenses, often providing financial assistance for tuition fees.
