Course offered

Bachelor of Science in Nursing (B. Sc. Nursing)

Four years (8 semesters) full-time course.

No. of seats: 55 (fifty-five)

1. Eligibility of Admission:

To be considered for admission to the B.Sc. Nursing program at Little Flower College of Nursing, applicants must meet the following requirements:

1.1 Nationality: Candidates must be Citizens of India/children or dependents of Non-resident Indians.

1.2 Age: Applicants should complete 17 years of age on or before 31st December 2025. The Maximum age limit for admission shall be 35 years. No relaxation of age will be allowed.

1.3 Academic qualification: The candidates should have passed the Higher Secondary School Certificate Examination (12 years course), Or Senior School Certificate Examination (10+2), Plus Two Examination (10+2), Or an equivalent with 12 years of schooling from a recognized board or university with 50% aggregate in Physics, Chemistry, Biology & English.

- The candidates belonging to socially and educationally backward classes (as per G.O.(P)No.208/66/Edn. dated 2.5.1966, G.O. (MS)No.95/08/SCSTDD dated 06.10.2008 and amendments thereof), will have a relaxation of 5% marks in the qualifying examination. The Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes candidates need only a pass in the qualifying examination.
- Candidates who have passed their qualifying examination from authorities other than the State of Kerala, except CBSE and ICSE, shall produce the certificate of recognition and equivalence of the qualifying examination from Kerala University of Health Sciences/ Directorate of HSE, Kerala.
- For grant of equivalency of Secondary School Educational qualification granted by any foreign country for the purpose of admission to B.Sc. Nursing courses, the student need to produce an equivalency certificate from the Association of Indian Universities (AIU), AIU House, 16, Commander, Intermit Gupta Marg, New Delhi – 110002 and also the requisite approval from the Indian Nursing Council.

2. Categorization of Seat as per Govt. order no188/2025/H&FWD DATED 7.7.2025

Government seats: - Merit seats against which the Director, LBS centre makes allotment are called Government Seats and shares 50% of the seats.

Management Seats: - **50%** Seats other than Government seats filled up by management from Christian minority

NRI seats: -15% of the management seats will be allotted for NRI candidates. As per Government order “An applicant who depends upon his/ her father/ Mother/ Brothers and Sisters, (inclusive of first cousins) Husband/ Wife Brothers and Sisters (inclusive of first cousins of father or mother/ Half Brother/ Half Sister/ Adopted Father or Adopted mother who is working abroad “will only be eligible to apply in the NRI category seats.

- (b) No opportunity will be given to incorporate any details or documents after the submission of application expect for those whose results are not declared before the last date of the submission of application.
- (c) The applicant is requested to visit the website frequently for updates from the date of the online application till the end of the admission process without fail.

4. Remittance of Application Fee & Submission of Application Form

There will be **Eleven Steps** for the submission of the application form and all steps are mandatory. Candidates must complete all the steps for the submission process.

1. Step 1: Open the website URL www.littleflowercn.ac.in on your available browser. (Prefer a higher version of chrome for best compatibility).
2. Step 2: Click B.Sc Nursing admission on the home page, you will find “instructions” for applying. Read the instructions carefully and press on “Apply now” button just below the heading “B.Sc Nursing Admission 2026-2027”.

3. Step 3: Register using Mail ID, date of birth and phone number.
4. Step 4: After registration you will receive a Login ID and password to your given Mail ID.
5. Step 5: Log in again using Login ID and Password sent to mail.
6. Step 6: Click change password and enter new desired password
7. Step 7: Application page will open. Under application details enter “Click to pay” to submit the application fee amount of Rs 1000/- and click “Next step”.
8. Step 8: The student details page will be displayed. Fill all mandatory information, click “Next step”.
9. Step 9: Next enter qualification details and click “Next step”.
10. Step 10: Enter document details and upload documents (10th certificate, 12th mark list & community certificate)
11. Step 11: Next step is to verify the given details and click finish and do “Final submission.”

NB:- For NRI candidates after step 8, please follow the below instructions.

1. Step 9: Enter details of NRI status, click “Next step”.
2. Step 10: Next enter qualification details and click “Next step”.
3. Step 11: Enter document details and upload documents (details given below) and click “Next step”.
4. Step 12: Next step is to verify the given details and click finish and do “Final submission”.

In case of submission of more than one application by the candidate, will consider only the completed application.

- *Application fee is non-refundable.*

NRI Seats

The Management is entitled to fill up to 15% of the total seats in the NRI category by admitting qualified students who are dependents of NRI. According to GO (MS)No.243/2014/H&FWD dated 06.08.2014, **“An applicant who depends upon his/her father/mother/brothers and sisters (inclusive of first cousins)/husband/wife/brothers and sisters (inclusive of first cousins) of father or mother/half-brother/half-sister/adopted father or adopted mother who is working abroad”** will only be eligible to apply in the NRI categoryseats.

5. Documents for NRI

- 5.1 A candidate applying for the NRI seat should submit the Passport copy and Visa/Green card/OCI Documents of their respective sponsors attested by Embassy/Consulate authorities. The job of the sponsor should be mentioned in any of the above documents.
- 5.2 The visa of the sponsor should be valid till the closing date of admission in respect of the closing date mentioned INC and Govt. of Kerala. (December 31st 2026)
- 5.3 In case, the employment of the sponsor is not mentioned in the above documents, the candidate has to produce the employment certificate of the sponsor attested by the Embassy/Consulate authorities.
- 5.4 The certificates clearly establishing the relationship of the sponsor with the candidate shall be obtained from the revenue authorities, as per the G.O (Ms) No.24/14/H&FWD dated 06.08.2014.
- 5.6 The Candidate shall produce the sworn affidavit from the sponsor in stamp paper. The same shall also be notarized by the Notary public, disclosing that the student is dependent of the sponsor and the all expenses i.e. Tuition fee and special fee, of the candidate for the entire course period will be borne by the sponsor.

5.7 All the certificates/documents required to establish NRI Status/Non Creamy Layer/Minority etc. shall be produced at the time of submission of application itself. The certificate produced later shall not be entertained under any circumstances.

NB: If the documents attached are not attested, valid, legible, the application will be rejected.

6. Fee structure

The fees to be paid at the time of admission to the Little Flower College of Nursing is given below. The fee structure has been provisionally approved by the Admission and Fee Regulatory Committee by order no.: ASC100/25/NURSING/LFCNT.

Note: - Apart from the schedule of fees given above, the students will be required to pay the university examination fee, Book and uniform fee, and Hostel and mess fee separately.

- Levy of fee on provisional basis is subject to modification depending on the fee regulated by the Fee Regulating Committee.

7. Selection & Rank list in Management & NRI Quota

7.1 The Management and NRI rank lists of all applicants will be published separately on the website, www.littleflowercn.ac.in on the basis of the total percentage of marks obtained in the core subjects Physics, Chemistry Biology and English in the (+2) qualifying examination.

7.2 Candidates who have passed the Higher Secondary Examination of the Board of Higher Secondary Education of Kerala or equivalent examinations recognized by any of the universities in the State of Kerala with an Aggregate of 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology and 50% marks in English in second year only are eligible for admission,

Illustration: -

If the highest mark secured by the students of the Kerala state HSE, in Physics is 100, and the highest mark secured by the student of any other board in the same subject is 90, the highest marks of both will be considered to be equal to 100. If a student of the other board secures 60 marks in Physics when the highest mark in Physics on the same board is 90, the 60 marks will be considered to be equal to 66.66 marks as arrived at below: $100 \times 60 / 90 = 66.66$.

In the case of a tie in the total marks, preference will be given based on the marks obtained for Biology. If there is still a tie, the marks in Chemistry and then Physics will be counted. If a tie still exists, the age of the candidate will be taken into account, the elder will be preferred to the younger.

7.3 The provisional rank list will be published on the website as per the admission schedule.

7.4 If an applicant does not take admission on getting an online allotment, she/he will lose all the claims for admission in the subsequent allotments.

7.5 Allotment will be notified online only and no personal intimation will be given.

7.6 An applicant who receives an online allotment will have to join within the notified date and time scheduled by submitting the original documents and remitting the fees payable to the College as indicated at the time of admission.

7.7 The process of allotment will continue until all the seats are filled.

7.8 **THE CUT-OFF DATE OF ADMISSION** - The deadline for closing the admission to the nursing program will be announced by the Kerala government, INC and KUHS.

NB: Applicants in NRI Quota must upload NRI documents listed to confirm the seats.

8.2 For genuine reasons management of the institution will deny admission to any candidate, even if otherwise eligible. Reasons for such denial will be recorded and intimated to the candidates concerned if requested.

9. The procedure of Spot Counselling, Allotment & Admission, if required

9.1 Spot counseling, allotment and admission in the merit rank order of applicants will be held to fill up the remaining vacant seats after three or four online allotments if required.

9.2 Those who receive allotment orders as per their existing rank shall submit their original certificates, pay the fees and complete admission at the College counter on the spot.

9.3 All original documents and certificates should be submitted at the college desk at the time of spot admission.

10. Candidates who express their intention to not to pursue studies

- 10.1 Candidates who express their intention not to pursue studies in the Nursing College before the last date fixed for closure of admissions will be eligible for refund of the 1st year tuition fee and other fees except admission fee. They will be eligible to get back their original certificates handed over to the college at the time of admission. In the case of students who leave the college midway, the right of the management for liquidated damages, if any, from such students will be determined by the competent “Civil Court”.
- 10.2 Besides, all candidates who opt to discontinue the course any time before completion of the course will have to pay hostel, mess and other fees proportionately for the period they remained on the rolls of the college.
- 10.3 Furnishing of false information/particulars would result in the cancellation of admission to the course if admitted and in addition, will attract the relevant provisions of criminal law of the land.

11. Career opportunities

11.1 Graduates of the B.Sc. Nursing program at Little Flower College of Nursing are well-prepared for careers as registered nurses in a variety of health care settings, including hospitals, clinics, nursing homes, and community health centers. They may also pursue advanced degrees in nursing or related fields.

12. Special instructions

- 12.1 Students are required to wear the uniform prescribed by the College in clinical and in class room.
- 12.2 Participation at all college-sponsored events is a requirement of students. For nursing students, the Student Nurses Association will offer opportunities for both professional and personal growth. Facilities for both indoor and outdoor games are offered, enabling them to make innovative and efficient use of their free time.
- 12.3 Students will be responsible for covering the entire cost of any educational travels that are scheduled during the semester.
- 12.4 During lectures, students should keep quiet in the classroom, the library, and the hallways.
- 12.5 Students should make every effort to take care of the college, hostel and hospital
- 12.6 Students are required to abide by the rules and regulations laid by the hospital, and college authorities. Violation of rules will entail disciplinary action.
- 12.7 Students are required to maintain ethical and professional standards and behaviors.
- 12.8 Students who are found to have major health problems and unable to continue the course viz., cardiac problems, epilepsy, tuberculosis, infectious skin diseases, psychiatric problems or any other major illness will have to discontinue their course and the fees paid will not be refunded.

13. Health Programme

Every student will get a yearly physical examination. When necessary, students will receive vaccinations against infectious diseases. If they become ill while enrolled, hospital checkup will be provided for a fee.

14. Hostel

Hostel facilities will be provided for Girls. Rooms are provided with furniture. They should not bring any valuable or jewellery. The college will not take any responsibility for loss or theft. Food will be provided in the hostel mess. The charges will be paid by the student at the end of the month. Boarding charges must be paid at the beginning of the academic year. The hostel's rules, must be read and signed by parents and students.

15. Ragging

Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited in the college and hostel. All the members of the college are committed to abolish ragging in their campus. Hence any student who indulges in any form of ragging will be subjected to penal actions as per provisions of law. Also the student will be expelled from the college as detailed in the law concerned.

16. Grievance Redressal

Any complaints/grievances of the applicants should be addressed to the Principal, Little Flower College of Nursing, Trivandrum which will be heard and disposed of at the earliest. If at all any issues before the AFRC, the college will adhere to the directions issued by the committee.

Before applying online, candidates should have a valid email (If you do not have an email address, recommended G mail).

Keep ready the following things to be submitted along with the online application.

Applicant's Photo:

Candidates need to upload passport-size photos. Candidates will require a scanned/digital image of their photograph, dimensions 150 (Width) x 200 (Height) pixels (preferred), and file size should be between 10 KB-200KB. (File formats: jpeg)

Signature of the Applicant:

Candidates need to upload their signature. Candidates should also have a scanned image of their signature. The Signature should not be in capital letters. The candidate should sign on white paper with black/blue ink pen. The preferred dimension for signature is 140 x 60 pixels and the file size should be less than 200 kb. (File formats: jpeg)

Scanned copies of certificates/documents to be submitted along with the online application:

- i. The relevant page of SSLC book/equivalent board certificate as proof of age and date of birth.
- ii. Certificate and mark list of qualifying examination (Plus Two/12th Std.) Or printout of the result sheet from the website File formats: jpg/.gif/.png/.pdf with a file size less than 1 MB
- iii. In case the candidate claims reservation under Christian Community Category, the Community Certificate is issued by the Diocese/Revenue authorities.
- iv. **In case of NRI seats, copy of the following documents duly attested to prove their status shall be submitted along with the application.**
- v. Copy of the Overseas Employment Certificate issued by the employer, **attested by the Embassy** OR if self-employed, a statement in this regard that is **duly attested by the Embassy**.
